Electric Zoo music festival	September 1 - 3, 2017	Electric Zoo is an electronic dance-music festival that brings top acts and 150,000 fans to Randall's Island Park each Labor Day weekend.

Tennis tournament	September 1 - 10, 2017 (begins Aug. 28)	Watch the world's best players compete under the open sky at the U.S. Open Tennis Championship at Arthur Ashe Stadium in Flushing Meadows.
Innovative theater festival	September 1 - 17, 2017 (begins Aug. 27)	See 23 new and innovative works, including comedy, dance, drama, music, poetry, and puppetry, during Dream Up Festival at Theater for the New City.

Caribbean festival & parade	September 4, 2017	Celebrate Caribbean culture and history at the lively New York Caribbean Carnival Parade (Labor Day Parade) , which has dancers in colorful costumes, reggae, and calypso music on Eastern Parkway, beginning at Schenectady Ave. and ending at Grand Army Plaza in Brooklyn with Caribbean food and craft vendors. New York Fashion Week	September 6 - 15, 2017	Top models, photographers, and designers attend

Trumpet festival	September 8 - 14, 2017	Festival of New Trumpet Music (FONT) offers a variety of concerts.
Labor Day parade	September 9, 2017 (10 a.m.)	Celebrate workers with the AFL-CIO at NYC Labor Day Parade on 5th Ave from 44th Street to 67th Street.
History celebration	September 9, 2017 (Sept. 10 if it rains)	The 1776 Peace Conference Celebration offers historic house tours, re-enactments, colonial dancing, outdoor cooking, crafters, music, and kids' activities at the Conference House in Staten Island
Crafts fair	September 9 - 10 and 16 - 17, 2017	Autumn Crafts Festival features hundreds of juried artists, entertainment, and craft demonstrations in tents outside Lincoln Center for the Performing Arts. Repeats in June. Free..
County fair on the Hudson	September 10, 2017 (1 to 6 p.m.)	Enjoy carnival rides & games, live bands, a sideshow, aerialists, and food vendors at West Side County Fair at Riverside Park South & W. 70th Street. Free.
Folk music in the park	September 10, 2017	Washington Square Park Folk Festival features an old time string band, blues, early country music, Turkish songs, and a square dance. Free.
SummerStage	September 10 - Oct. 8, 2017, 2017	Enjoy outstanding music, comedy, theater, dance, lectures, and films during SummerStage in city parks. The (mostly) free concerts are popular, so arrive early.
Tribute in Light	September 11, 2017	Tribute in Light is two brilliant beams that shine into the sky all night near the World Trade Center site.
Book festival	September 11 - 17, 2017	Brooklyn Book Festival includes a lively book market, author readings, and panel discussions on Sunday

		at Borough Hall in Brooklyn, plus a preceding week of literary events throughout the borough. Free.
Photo expo	September 13 - 24, 2017	View photographs in a village of shipping containers, hear talks by photographers and editors, watch projections at night, and visit a beer garden and food trucks at Photoville at Brooklyn Bridge Plaza. Free.
Oyster Week	September 15 - 28, 2017	Oyster Week is a series of adventurous dining events and activities that benefit sustainable aquaculture.
Italian street fair	September 14 - 24, 2017	The Feast of San Gennaro is popular for its religious procession, colorful parades, live music, ethnic foods, and a famous cannoli-eating contest in Little Italy at Mulberry & Grand streets. Free.
German parade	September 16, 2017 (noon)	See German-American marching bands, floats, dance groups, and walkers in traditional costumes in the Steuben Parade on Fifth Avenue (from 65th Street to 86th Street). Free or buy grandstand seats .
Tasting in East Village	September 16, 2017 (12 to 5 p.m.)	Sample dishes from 15 East Village restaurants, with live entertainment and local musicians, at the Taste of East Village on E. 7th Street (from Cooper Square to 2nd Avenue).
New ideas festival	September 16, 2017	Ideas City includes visionary speakers, exhibits of innovative design, performances, and tours to celebrate creativity and the exchange of ideas at Sara D. Roosevelt Park in the Bowery. Free.
Marine science festival	September 16, 2017 (11 a.m. to 4 p.m.)	Learn about the oceans from marine scientists, tour a boat, and visit the kid zone at Submerge on Pier 26 in Hudson River Park. Free.
Bike rides	September 16, 2017	Escape New York has scenic rides ranging from 25 to 100 miles. Begin in Sakura Park,

		cross the George Washington Bridge, and return to a finish-line festival.
Irish fair	September 16, 2017	The Great Irish Fair of New York is a family-friendly event with Irish music, dancing, vendors, and a kids' area at The Amphitheater at Coney Island.
Taste of North Brooklyn	September 17, 2017	Taste samples from 34 local restaurants and bars with live music at Taste Williamsburg Greenpoint at the State of New York - East River State Park in Brooklyn for age 21+.
Latin street fair in Queens	September 17, 2017	Carnaval de la Cultura Latina promises "art, music, dance, and great food from Latino cultures, as well as a day of fun for the whole family" on Junction Boulevard (from Roosevelt to 37th Avenue). Free.
Brooklyn street fair	September 17, 2017	Flatbush Frolic offers music, dance, food, a children's area, local vendors, and arts and crafts. Free.
German festival	September 17, 2017 (12 to 11 p.m.)	Ompahfest features German and Austrian food, beer, music, and dance at Plattduetsche Park in Franklin Square.
Horse show	September 20 - 24, 2017	Watch show jumping and exhibition acts, with a family day on Sept. 24 at Central Park Horse Show in Wollman Rink at Central Park
Film festival	September 20 - 24, 2017	Urbanworld Film Festival features films and panel discussions that support and develop content creators of color at AMC 34th St. Theater and SVA Theatre.
Burlesque festival	September 21 - 24, 2017	New York Burlesque Festival is four nights of bump and grind by 100 performers in feathers and lace, including a glittery razzle-dazzle spectacular on Saturday.
Latino film festival	September 21 - 24, 2017	Viva! Latino Film Festival screens subtitled shorts, feature films, documentaries, and music videos at

		Downtown Community Television Center.
Free museum day	September 23, 2017	Get a free ticket that allows two people to visit one of the many museums participating in Museum Day Live .
Intimacy expo	September 23 - 24, 2017	Hear 20 speakers and visit vendors at Sex Expo N.Y. at Brooklyn Expo Center. Free.
Maker fair	September 23 - 24, 2017	Browse hundreds of exhibits about science, art, creativity, and innovation, and meet the makers at World Maker Faire New York at New York Hall of Science in Queens.
County fair in Queens	September 23 - 24, 2017	Queens County Fair has pie-eating and corn-husking contests, pig racing, farm animals, hayrides, carnival rides, a midway, a beer garden, craft and food vendors, and bands at Queens County Farm Museum.
Bus Festival	September 24, 2017	Board vintage buses, and meet bus drivers and historians during the Bus Festival on Boerum Place (from State Street to Atlantic Avenue). Free.
Street festival	September 24, 2017 (12 to 6 p.m.)	Atlantic Avenue is filled with arts and craft vendors, music stages, food booths, and kids' activities during Atlantic Antic . Free.
Tunnel to Towers 5K	September 24, 2017	Tunnel to Towers Run/Walk honors and provides financial support to our first responders and military.
New York Film Festival	September 28 - Oct. 15, 2017	See classics, documentaries, and full-length feature films by the world's great filmmakers at the New York Film Festival (NYFF) .
Pumpkin festival	September 30 - Oct. 29, 2017	Pumpkin Picking at Decker Farm features hayrides, face painting, farm animals, farmhouse tours, arts and crafts, a corn maze, and a pumpkin patch at a historic working farm in Staten Island.
