<b>Bad theater</b>	November 1 - 5, 2016	<a href="#">Bad Theater Fest</a> welcomes new writers and actors, often with hilarious results, at 334 South 5th Street in Brooklyn.
<b>Comedy festival</b>	November 1 - 6, 2016	<a href="#">New York Comedy Festival</a> features big-name comedians, special sketch and improvisational comedy, panel discussions, and benefits.
<b>White Light Festival</b>	November 1 - 16, 2016 (begins Oct. 16)	See world-class performances, films, and artist talks with a focus on music during <a href="#">White Light Festival</a> at Lincoln Center for the Performing Arts.
<b>Winter in Bryant Park</b>	November 1, 2016 - Jan. 2, 2017 (starts Oct. 29)	<a href="#">Winter Village at Bryant Park</a> has 125 holiday kiosk shops, an ice-skating rink open until March 5. Free unless you rent skates.
<b>Art prints</b>	November 2 - 6, 2016	Find affordable art at the <a href="#">Print Fair</a> at Park Avenue Armory.
<b>Tango festival</b>	November 3 - 13, 2016	See performances and concerts, or take classes that range from beginner to advanced at <a href="#">Shall We Tango NYC</a> .
<b>Electronic music</b>	November 4 - 12, 2016	<a href="#">Brooklyn Electronic Music Festival</a> showcases emerging and established artists in Williamsburg.
<b>Pumpkin Smash</b>	November 2 or 5, 2016	Bring a pumpkin to smash at <a href="#">Pumpkin Smash</a> , and it will end up as compost. Click the

		location to see date and hours. Also at <a href="#">Clement Clarke Moore Park</a> . Free.

<b>New York Marathon</b>	November 6, 2016	The world-famous <a href="#">New York City Marathon</a> begins in Staten Island and runs through all five boroughs before ending at Central Park. Stand along Central Park South to cheer on the finishers. Free to watch.
<b>Bronx restaurant deals</b>	November 7 - 18, 2016	Dozens of restaurants offer special lunch and dinner menus or 15% off your bill during <a href="#">Savor the Bronx</a> .
<b>Horror film festival</b>	November 10 - 13, 2016	The competitive <a href="#">NYC Horror Film Festival (NYCHFF)</a> shows short and full-length films near Times Square.
<b>Documentary film festival</b>	November 10 - 17, 2016	See 150 interesting documentary films, and attend galas on opening and closing nights at <a href="#">Doc NYC</a> .
<b>Veterans Day Parade</b>	November 11, 2016	<a href="#">America's Parade</a> entertains 600,000 spectators as it goes up Fifth Avenue from 26th to 52nd Street. The opening ceremony is at 10 a.m., wreath laying at 11 a.m., and parade at approximately 11:15 a.m. Free
<b>Fine art show</b>	November 11 - 14, 2016 (party Nov. 10)	See contemporary design, decorative art, antiques, and ethnographic art from around the world at <a href="#">The Salon Art + Design</a> in the Park Avenue Armory.
<b>Craft fair</b>	November 12 - 13, 2016	Shop from 225 artisans, chefs, and vintage vendors at <a href="#">Renegade Craft Fair</a> at the Metropolitan Pavilion. Free.
<b>Football</b>	November 13 & 27, 2016	Watch the <a href="#">New York Jets</a> play at MetLife Stadium.

<b>Thanksgiving scavenger hunt</b>	. November 19, 2016	<a href="#">Cranksgiving</a> is a scavenger hunt on your bicycle for Thanksgiving food that you donate to a food bank, plus a party. Bring \$20, a bag/pack, and a bike lock.
<b>Craft show</b>	November 19 - 20, 2016	<a href="#">American Fine Craft Show</a> features high-quality works from 90 juried craft artists at Brooklyn Museum.

<b>The Nutcracker</b>	November 25 - Dec. 31, 2016	<a href="#">George Balanchine's The Nutcracker</a> is a holiday tradition with old-fashioned costumes, a tree that grows before your eyes, crystal-shaped snowflakes, fine choreography by New York City Ballet, and Tchaikovsky's captivating music at David H. Koch Theater..
<b>Brooklyn Holiday Bazaar</b>	November 26 - 27, 2016	<a href="#">Brooklyn Holiday Bazaar</a> features handpicked local artisans, food vendors, and craft activities for kids in Gowanus, Brooklyn. Free.
<b>Christmas play</b>	November 27 - Dec. 30, 2016	<a href="#">A Christmas Carol</a> is Charles Dickens' classic about Ebenezer Scrooge, Christmas ghosts, and Tiny Tim at cozy Players Theatre in Greenwich Village.
<b>Lincoln Square holiday festival</b>	November 28, 2016	<a href="#">Winter's Eve at Lincoln Square</a> features a tree lighting in Dante Park, a brass band, dancing, evening food tastings from local restaurants, and activities and entertainment for kids along Broadway. Free.
<b>Holiday market - Central Park</b>	November 29 - Dec. 24, 2016	Enjoy a hot beverage or meal, and shop for gifts from 100 vendors at the <a href="#">Columbus Circle Holiday Market</a> at Central Park West and 59th Street. Free

<b>Christmas tree lighting</b>	November 30, 2016 (7 to 9 p.m.)	Brave the crowds and winter weather to watch the <a href="#">Rockefeller Center Tree Lighting</a> and live entertainment. The tree stays lit until Jan. 7 at 9 p.m. Free.
