<b>Free Summer Movies</b>	June 2 - Sept. 20, 2017 (begins in May)	<a href="#">Free Summer Movies</a> are shown evenings at parks in Manhattan, Queens, Brooklyn, and the Bronx.
<b>Multicultural festival</b>	June 3, 2017	<a href="#">NYC Multicultural Festival</a> promises diverse cultural music, dance, food, fashion, and a kids' area at the bandshell at Jackie Robinson Park. Free
<b>Brooklyn street party</b>	June 3, 2017 (11 a.m. to 7 p.m.)	The young seeking fun will line up in the sun to enter the <a href="#">Bushwick Block Party</a> , which has two music stages, 39 street artists, food trucks and beer at Troutman Street & St. Nicholas Avenue in Brooklyn. Free.

<b>Crafts festival</b>	June 3 - 4 and 10 - 11, 2017	<a href="#">American Crafts Festival</a> features hundreds of juried artists, entertainment, and craft demonstrations in tents outside the Lincoln Center for the Performing Arts. Repeats in Oct. Free.
<b>SummerStage</b>	June 3 - Sept. 22, 2017 (begins in May)	Enjoy outstanding music, comedy, theater, dance, lectures, and films during <a href="#">SummerStage</a> in city parks. The (mostly) free concerts are popular, so arrive early.

<b>Native American festival</b>	June 4, 2017	<a href="#">Drums Along the Hudson</a> features traditional dance, drumming, crafts, and foods at Inwood Hill Park. Free.
<b>Freshkills Park preview STATEN ISLAND</b>	June 4, 2017	Get a sneak peek at the park built on a Staten Island landfill on <a href="#">Discovery Day</a> , when you can walk 8 miles of trails, bike 5 miles of pavement, run a 5K course, or register for a kayak tour. Free.
<b>Taste of Times Square</b>	June 5, 2017	<a href="#">Taste of Times Square</a> features international food from 50 restaurants, music from local bands, African drumming, and street performers in Times Square.
<b>Music at Washington Square</b>	June 6 - 27, 2017 (8 p.m. Tuesdays)	<a href="#">Washington Square Music Festival</a> performs classical music in the park. Free.

<b>Free museum evening</b>	June 13, 2017 (6 to 9 p.m.)	Join the crowds listening to live music and visiting seven museums for three hours during <a href="#">Museum Mile Festival</a> on 5th Avenue. Free.
<b>Music in the park</b>	June 13 - 18, 2017	Hear classical music outdoors under the stars at <a href="#">New York Philharmonic Concerts in the Parks</a> , followed by fireworks. (June 18 is indoors without fireworks on <b>STATEN ISLAND</b> .)
<b>Free arts festival</b>	June 14 - 25, 2017	Attend 50 cultural performances and events at <a href="#">River to River Festival</a> [slow website], including dance, film, music, poetry, theater, and visual arts. Free.

<b>Craft fair</b>	June 17 - 18, 2017	Shop from 200 artisans, chefs, and vintage vendors at <a href="#">Renegade Craft Fair</a> at Brooklyn Expo Center. Free.
<b>Father's Day restaurants</b>	June 18, 2017	<a href="#">OpenTable</a> lists restaurants that offer special brunch, lunch, and dinner menus on Father's Day.
